Ref: Multiple fatalities of unarmed protestors in Western Iran.

Despite the brutal crackdown by the Islamic Republic security forces against unarmed civilians, the homegrown and organic revolution in Iran has continued and gained strength.

The Western Iranian cities of Mahabad and Javanrood, located in the province of Kurdistan, are now under an intense crackdown with the use of military ammunition and unconfirmed reports of the use of HexaChloroEthane grenades which can be fatal.

Videos uploaded to many social media platforms, which have a running commentary with times and dates, clearly show the intensive and brutal crackdown faced by the protestors. These videos also show multiple fatalities and injuries.

In line with the Islamic Republic's procedure to quell the protests, the internet has now been shut down.

The theocratic dictatorship will continue to massacre unarmed civilians. The international community has now witnessed the deaths of many hundreds of youngsters, which includes over 50 minors.

Unless direct action is taken by the U.K and allied governments, the Islamic Republic will continue with the systematic massacre of unarmed protestors.

Action against many individuals, as well as the so-called morality police, has been taken and the democracies, as well as the international community, have stood in

solidarity with the Iranian revolution, a revolution spearheaded by Human Rights and in particular women's Rights.

Regardless, the genocide of an entire generation continues and yet the revolution has held firm. Action and holding the Islamic Republic to account, as well as imposing stern sanctions may persuade the regime in Tehran to cease this merciless killing.

As you are aware, the Iranian parliament has voted unanimously to execute many of the arrested protestors. Virgins are to be raped, or 'temporarily married to a guard' on the eve of their execution. Direct action and sanctions may avert this massacre.

The Iranian revolution has entered its third month. This is not a protest regarding just Human Rights. This is a revolution aimed at regime change and unarmed civilians are gunned down, tortured, and raped. The free world needs to take action now by closing the Islamic Republic embassies in U.K and E.U, banning Iranian registered aircraft from flying into U.K and E.U airspace, banning Iranian merchant ships from docking in U.K and E.U ports as well as ensuring the sanctions that are already in effect to be policed accordingly. The democracies need to consider the withdrawal of their representatives from Tehran and ensure the Iranian government cannot trade in the U.K and E.U by circumventing sanctions.

The dictatorship in Tehran will only respond to force, not words of solidarity.

We sincerely hope that the U.K government will take the required action with no further delay as unarmed innocent civilians are massacred on a daily basis.
