Petition to UK Parliamentarians: Urgent Action Required to Halt Executions in Iran

To the Honourable Members of the UK Parliament,

We, the undersigned, urgently call upon you to take immediate and decisive action to address the grave human rights violations occurring in Iran. The recent sentencing of the “Ekbatan boys” to execution, following sham trials and forced confessions, is a stark reminder of the brutal tactics employed by the Iranian regime to suppress dissent and silence opposition.

We implore you to:

- **Condemn the Executions:** Publicly denounce the death sentences handed down to these young men and others who have been unjustly convicted.
- **Diplomatic Pressure:** Urge the UK Government to protest at the highest diplomatic levels against these executions and demand their immediate halt.
- **Sanctions and Measures:** Advocate for the imposition of additional sanctions on Iranian officials and entities responsible for these human rights abuses. Make it clear that the UK will not tolerate the continued killing of innocent people.
- **International Collaboration:** Work with international partners to hold the Iranian regime accountable for its actions and to support efforts aimed at ending the use of torture and forced confessions in Iran.

The UK has a proud history of standing up for human rights and justice. We must not remain silent in the face of such egregious violations. By taking these steps, we can help to protect the lives of those who are at risk and send a strong message that the international community will not tolerate such inhumane practices.

We urge you to act swiftly and decisively to make life difficult for the Islamic Republic of Iran to continue its campaign of repression and violence against its own people.
