Mr. Dr. Pezeshkian, President of the Islamic Republic,

After decades of mismanagement and suppression of popular movements, Iran is today facing deep and widespread crises; from water, electricity, and energy shortages to severe livelihood problems that have affected people's daily lives. The widespread protests and dissatisfaction in recent years indicate that a majority of society is unsatisfied with the current situation.

Recent developments and rising tensions on the international stage—especially the risk of the expansion of war—have created serious concerns about the country's security and future. Continuing on this path could worsen the economic, social, and public health conditions of the Iranian people.

Therefore, as concerned patriots, we ask you to consider the national interest and prevent further harm by **“drinking the poison chalice,” as your leader Mr. Khomeini did, and by accepting defeat, bring the war to an end.**

It is suggested that by accepting existing realities and preparing the ground for a **peaceful transfer of power to a transitional government under the leadership of Crown Prince Reza Pahlavi**, a political vacuum and chaos in the country can be avoided. Crown Prince Reza Pahlavi has a clear plan, along with a team of specialists, to form a temporary government and is the only guarantee of stability for Iran's near future after the fall of the Islamic Republic.

The Islamic Republic will fall today or tomorrow. It is obvious that **responsibility for the current painful conditions of Iranian society lies solely with the leaders of the Islamic Republic**, whose senior figures are gradually disappearing.
